COMMENTS:

1. How does this proposed field trip focus on helping students acquire the knowledge and skills described in the Common Core of Learning established by the Board of Education?

- The Spanish immersion trip will provide students a truly authentic learning experience in which they will be able to practice all of the skills they have acquired in their Spanish classes in a completely hands-on way. The Massachusetts Common Core of Learning states that students should be able to, “read, write, and converse in at least one language in addition to English.” Immersion in Spanish, through the daily classes taught at Idiomas Carlos V will enhance students’ abilities to express themselves in Spanish and use what they are learning in the classroom in real-life scenarios and workshops each day. Additionally, the Common Core states that in order to succeed in the 21st century, students must “respect and understand people of different backgrounds in our diverse society.” As students will be immersed in Spanish culture through the time they spend with their professors and local guides and during their many excursions through central and southern Spain they will be constantly making connections between American and Spanish cultures and societies.

2. How is the proposed field trip integrated into the curriculum, or are content materials reflective of one of the core subject areas as described in the Common Core of Learning established by the Board of Education?

- The proposed trip is integrated into the curriculum because Spanish students will be participating in daily language immersion classes and workshops during the trip. They will also learn through authentic experiences and excursions where they are exposed to the rich history and cultures of Spain. Post-travel learning assessments will require them to present, in either speaking or writing, experiences that they had over the course of their trip. Spanish language and culture is at the center of our curriculum and both of these elements will be the core of the immersion program. Students will be exposed to first-hand cultural and linguistic experiences and be tasked with communicating any needs or other ideas completely in Spanish. Also, the Common Core states that students must, “Know and understand the development and structure of English and other languages and how learning another language fosters appreciation of peoples and cultures.” The exchange program will certainly address cultural awareness and appreciation.

3. How does the proposed field trip have learning outcomes consistent with the knowledge and skills described in the Common Core of Learning established by the Board of Education?

- The learning outcomes of the proposed field trip are consistent with the knowledge and skills described in the Common Core in that students will “use languages [Spanish] other than English within and beyond the school setting.” Also, throughout the course of the exchange program students will be required to draw upon knowledge and skills that they have acquired both in their Spanish classes and other content areas. The Common Core states that, “We believe that the quality of each student’s future will depend on his or her ability to gain and apply knowledge. Linking skills and knowledge acquired across the disciplines is crucial to student success in school and in the workplace of tomorrow.” Students will continually be tasked with “linking skills and knowledge” while communicating during their classes and workshops, calculating exchange rates, using historical knowledge to better understand sites and experiences, etc.

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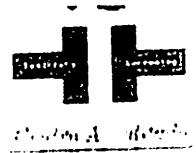

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
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
