


- All sophomores passed the ServSafe Exam & Allergen Exam

- International Beauty Show in New York City








#### HVAC

- Transportation received \$22,000 waterborne paint system donated by Colours INC. of Plymouth.






### <u>CAD</u>

- 2023 SkillsUSA National Champion: Facilithon - Annalise Lopes






