EXPECT MORE

- ★ Plymouth Harbor Academy services 48 students
 - 32 Seniors (5 graduating in January)
 - 3 of the 5 are enrolled in college classes at Quincy and CCCC
 - 8 Juniors
 - o 8 Sophomores
- ★ 14 new students this Spring semester
- ★ PHA's dedicated staff includes 1 Director, 5 teachers (including 1 Special Educator), 1 Adjustment/Guidance School Counselor and 3 0.5 paraprofessionals (1 serving as a Job Coach and driver of the school van)



EXPECT MORE

- ★ Cost saving program providing alternative setting for students at risk for outplacement or dropout
- ★ PHA programs are geared toward providing students relevant, project based learning opportunities relative to their life now and in the future
- ★ Support students who have the desire to earn their high school diploma, but may have experienced academic difficulties, poor attendance, social/emotional difficulties and/or behavioral challenges
- ★ PHA tries to eliminate student stressors by creating a student-focused environment, catered to individual learning styles



★ PHA is increasing the work-study program, helping students:

- Complete job applications;
- Develop interview skills;
- Find job opportunities that not only match their skills and interests, but also allow them the opportunity to grow professionally
- ★ Students have also received assistance with learner's permit and driver's license applications, where transportation is oftentimes an obstacle for students to get to work
- ★ One student is enrolled at Diamond Aesthetics Academy; Lynn, MA





West Elementary CARE program

- Student-mentor program
- PHA students will be formally trained in mentoring younger students in a positive productive way
- Perfect way for PHA's young adults to give back to the school system and their community
- PHA students prepare a lesson to present to WES Care Program students
- Lessons cover life skills and emotional health





HiPoint Counseling Services

- In-school therapy program for students
 - Provided in response to student requests for assistance
 - Bypasses waitlists for outside counseling
 - > Eliminates transportation barriers for students
 - Provides opportunities for students to meet with HiPoint Counselor weekly at school
 - Allows students to address their mental health, resulting in higher academic achievement





Quincy College

- College/Job Fair
 - Juniors and Seniors have been invited to job fair in Spring, 2024
 - Students will be educated on employment opportunities
 - Education & skill sets needed to attain positions of interest will be addressed
 - Assist students with an employment/education plan beyond high school





Quincy College

- Dual Enrollment Program
 - Expand PHA course offerings
 - ➤ Provide students the chance to study at PHA campus while in high school and transition to Quincy College Plymouth campus
 - ➤ Even if students choose not to pursue higher education immediately after graduation, PHA students will have familiarity with a local college

- Partnered with Youth Works program to provide student employment
- 10 students participated
