# How have feelings about PNHS changed over time?

**86.1%** of Parents rated North a "4" or a "5", and **49%** rated North at

#### **INSTRUCTION AT PNHS:**

<u>In 2018:</u> only **66%** of Parents and **62%** of teachers rated instruction a "4" or "5".

<u>In 2025:</u> **83%** Parents rated core courses, **85%** for Electives, **and 81%** and APs a "4" or "5".

In 2024: 89% of teachers rated Instruction a "4" or "5".

#### **VOICE AT PNHS:**

In 2018: only 44% of Teachers rated voice in decision making "4" or a "5". 4.6% gave it a "5".

In 2024: 80% of teachers rated voice a "4" or a "5".

#### **COMMUNICATION AT PNHS:**

<u>In 2018</u>: **61%** of Parents thought Parent - Teacher communication was a "4" or "5".

<u>In 2025:</u> **72%** Parents rated Parent - Teacher Comm. "4" or "5".

<u>In 2025</u>: **80%** Parents rated the Frequency & Clarity of School Updates as a "4" or "5".

#### CO-CURRICULAR PROGRAMS AT PNHS:

In 2018: 68% of Parents rated programs a "4" or "5".

<u>In 2025:</u> **80%** of Parents rated a "4" or a "5" to Sports, **78%** to Clubs, and **86%** to our Arts Programs.

# **GOAL ONE: CURRICULUM ALIGNMENT & PUBLICATION**

#### Year 1 & 2:

- Allow staff curated opportunities to visit other teachers, classes, & departments.
- **Engage Staff in completing a school wide document** on a single template that includes content, essential questions, major projects, soft skills & transition goals.

#### **Year 2 & 3**:

- <u>Publication of Paper Document</u> for School Reference of Schoolwide Curriculum.

### Year 1 & 2:

- **Review NEASC Standards, Examples & Current School Wide Goals** among multiple staff members to help identify the expectations for a successfully crafted vision of the graduate.
- **Create School Wide Opportunities** for input that allow for confirmation or additional input on transition goals and vision of the graduate for PNHS.

### **Year 2 & 3**:

- **Develop the PNHS Vision of the Graduate** building wide. Communicate and integrate vision into courses, culture and expectations at PNHS.
- **Develop and Execute the PNHS NEASC Self Study** in preparation for our Fall, 2027 Collaborative Conference.

#### **Successful Result:**

 A well crafted, shared vision of what success looks like for a PNHS graduate that is integrated into our courses and communicated in a completed self study for our NEASC Accreditation Collaborative Conference.
